USE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

SPRAY CHALLENGER ON... RINSE GREASE AND DIRT OFF!

Grease and grime will just wash away if you follow these easy directions. Always apply CHALLENGER onto the surface first. Then rinse well with water, preferably warm or hot. If the area to be cleaned is very greasy, allow Challenger to penetrate for a minute or two. See directions for diluting.

DILUTE CHALLENGER AND SAVE MONEY!

CHALLENGER PC-737 is a strong concentrate and meant to be diluted for most purposes. You'll find you can save money by diluting CHALLENGER and have the convenience of one cleaner/degreaser to tackle every cleaning challenge. CHALLENGER may be diluted up to a ratio of 2 oz. per gallon of water. When diluting, the best guideline to follow is "the greasier the surface, the more CHALLENGER you'll need." On very greasy surfaces, CHALLENGER may be used full strength. Always dilute at least 4 to 1 with water before spraying on soft paints such as latex or white metals such as aluminum or magnesium.

TEST IN AN INCONSPICUOUS AREA BEFORE USING.

METHODS OF CLEANING:

BY HAND: Apply with a spray bottle (dilute as necessary), let CHALLENGER penetrate the surface for a minute or so and rinse with water.

POWER WASHERS, FLOOR SCRUBBERS, ETC.: Prespray surface with a garden sprayer. Rinse with water using a garden hose or power washer. For floor scrubbers, follow manufacturer's directions.

CAUTIONS: CONTAINS POTASSIUM HYDROXIDE AND TETRAPOTASSIUM PYROPHOSPHATE. May be fatal if swallowed. Causes severe eye and skin burns. Do not taste, swallow or breathe. Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Always use protective clothing, including long sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, waterproof shoes or boots, safety goggles and rubber gloves. DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER CHEMICALS OR HOUSEHOLD PRODUCTS. Close container after each use. Do not transfer to unlabeled containers.
