Product Name: Deck Wash

USE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

ATTENTION: Always secure cap and transport bottle in upright position.

Directions:

- Always wear safety glasses to protect eyes, and rubber gloves to protect hands.
- Dress appropriately, deck wash will permanently stain clothing and shoes.
- Surface should be thoroughly dry and free of debris before application.
- Always test in a small, inconspicuous area to ensure you are satisfied with results.
- Apply with plastic pump-up sprayer. Product is ready to use, no mixing.
- Do not mix with any chemicals such as Muriatic acid, drain cleaner, rust removers, or ammonia containing products, as dangerous fumes will result.
- Wait 5-10 minutes for best results - No scrubbing, sanding or scraping needed.
- Thoroughly rinse off entire surface and surrounding area with large volumes of water to complete cleansing action.
- Stubborn stains may require a second application.

CAUTION: SKIN AND EYE IRRITANT. Contains Sodium Hypochlorite. USE ONLY WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION. FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.

If breathing difficulties are noticed or eyes water - STOP - ventilation is inadequate. Leave area immediately.
